

*Rules & Regulations*  
*Miss Spanish Festival Queen II*  
*Queen's Contract*

- I. Miss Spanish Festival Queen must be between the ages of 18-23 by November 1<sup>st</sup> 2016 and must be a resident of Louisiana. Miss Spanish Festival Queen must be single and remain so during the term of her reign. Miss Spanish Festival Queen must NOT be living with someone of the opposite sex or significant other, nor had a child.
- II. Miss Spanish Festival Queen must NOT hold any other titles, other than school or college, and may not enter any other pageants throughout their reign as Miss Spanish Festival Queen.
- III. The newly crowned Miss Spanish Festival Queen is required to travel throughout the state of Louisiana. In the event, if a Queen accepts an invitation to attend a function, she must present herself in a lady-like manner at all times. Any bad conduct while representing El Festival Española de Nueva Iberia will require an immediate dismissal. Miss Spanish Festival Queen must be present during the entire event as invited except in cases of illness, death, or the permission of the inviting director. Miss Spanish Festival Queen is expected to be dressed appropriately. No Jeans or Shorts, unless the invitation specifically recommends.
- IV. If any of the above rules are broken, the consequences are at the discretion of the director. Consequences may include, but are not limited to removal of title upon the Festival Board.
- V. Miss Spanish Festival Queen is expected to attend a minimum of (15) LAFF Festivals/Pageant events throughout her reign. Here are the required Festivals/Pageant events that the Miss Queen should attend.
  - Louisiana Sugar Cane Festival- New Iberia
  - Jr., Teen, & Miss Iberia Pageant- New Iberia
  - Cajun Hot Sauce Festival- New Iberia
  - Delcambre Shrimp Festival- Delcambre
  - Erath's 4<sup>th</sup> of July Festival- Erath
  - Louisiana Cattle Festival- Abbeville
  - Frog Festival- Rayne

- VI. Miss Spanish Festival Queen is responsible for the maintenance and carrying of her custom crown, banner, scepter, train and mantle. If any destruction occurs of crown, banner, scepter, train and mantle the Queen will be responsible for the expenses.
- VII. Miss Spanish Festival Queen is required to send a quarterly report with her travel appearances and locations to the director. Miss Spanish Festival Queen is required to attend the quarterly Spanish Festival Board meetings throughout her year as Queen.
- VIII. Miss Spanish Festival Queen is required to attend New Iberia events where she is invited to, including but not limited to: New Iberia's 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade and activities, Dragon Boat Races, Gumbo Cook-Off, Christmas Parade, Mardi Gras Parade, & Farmer's Markets. We also encourage the Miss Spanish Festival Queen to take part in volunteering/community service throughout her reign as queen. Miss Spanish Festival Queen is expected to participate in the Annual Spanish King's Ball in April 2017 and the Festival Poster Unveiling Ceremony in October 2017.
- IX. The newly crowned Miss Spanish Festival Queen agrees to spend the 2016 El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia November 18<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup>, by participating in various events throughout the Festival weekend. From the Friday night Spanish Gala to the Thanksgiving Mass on Sunday.
- X. Miss Spanish Festival Queen agrees to allow El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia to use her information and photographs to promote the Spanish Festival. Miss Spanish Festival Queen agrees El Festival Español de Nueva Iberia, La Association de Nueva Iberia, and pageant director are not responsible for loss of personal belongings, accidents or illnesses during her travels.
